



# Anything BUT Contest Rules

Please review and retain to refer to as necessary

## **COMPETITION:**

Following KCBS judging procedures the ancillary contest will be held on Friday evening, May 28th, 2010. entry fee into the ancillary contests will be \$20.00. The flat fee covers all three categories. Multiple entries into any category are allowed but it would require an additional \$20.00 entry fee. Entries may only be submitted by Pro Team or Back Yard contestants. Prizes and awards will be awarded in each ancillary category as follows:

1st Place = \$100.00 / 2nd Place = \$50.00 / 3rd Place = \$25.00

## **BBQ SAUCE:**

Turn in Time: 6:00pm

Identical Styrofoam containers with lids will be supplied to all competitors upon check in. Each entry will require six samples. All six samples will be passed on an identical tray.

Teams may enter one sauce per paid entry fee. A team may enter a maximum of two sauces if they pay for two separate entry fees.

Sauce does not have to be prepared on site.

Non-seasoned pork butt will be supplied for the judges to sample the sauce. This will be prepared by the culinary staff at the resort in a regular oven.

## **CHILI OR STEW:**

Turn in Time: 6:30pm

The type of chili or stew presented is at the cook's discretion. There are no requirements as to ingredients but we ask that you keep the "HOT" spiciness to a level that a normal human being would eat and not seek immediate medical attention. Garnish or toppings are allowed but they must fit inside the container.

Nothing is allowed to be served on the side.

Beans and other fillers are allowed in the Chili. No other rules from any other association will apply.

Chili and stews may be prepared ahead of time but all entries must be handled in a safe manner and must be heated to a safe food serving temperature.

Identical containers with lids will be supplied. It's up to the cook's discretion to use the lid or not. Judges will be supplied with spoons to sample. Each entry will require six samples. All six samples will be passed on an identical tray.

Teams may enter one chili or stew per paid entry fee. A team may enter a maximum of two entries in any combination if they pay for two separate entry fees.

Multiple entries from the same team must be significantly different in both appearance and content.

## **DESSERT:**

Turn in Time: 7:00pm

The dessert entry may be completed prior to arrival to the Showdown

Teams may enter one dessert per paid entry fee. A team may enter a maximum of two desserts if they pay for two separate entry fees.

Multiple entries from the same team must be significantly different in both appearance and content.

The entry may be submitted in any container the cook chooses however, there must be enough for six judges to sample. The dessert entry must fit onto an 18x24 inch half sheet serving pan that will be provided.
