Guided Hiking – Miller Trek

Our Hiking Trails at Brasstown Valley Resort are located in the Chattahoochee National Forest. As you travel along the trail, you will see a variety of flowering plants, which range in variety as the elevation changes from 2,000 feet to the trails highest point of 3,200 feet above sea level.

One hour guided hike (*2 person minimum*).....\$15 per person

Crane Creek Vineyard

Enjoy a glass of wine and the breath-taking scenic view of the quaint mountain vineyard. Nestled in the North Georgia Mountains, Crane Creek Vineyards is only minutes away from Brasstown Valley Resort & Spa. Tasting arrangements include a wine tasting and transportation. Tour arrangements include a Vintner's Tour of the winery, a wine tasting, cheese and crackers, a souvenir wine glass, and transportation. (*Vintner's Tour requires 48 hr notice*) (*Winery closed Mondays*) (*2 person minimum*)

Brasstown Bald

Brasstown Bald is Georgia's highest mountain, rising 4,784 feet above sea level. While there, visitors can see exhibits featuring the natural and cultural history of the area, access four hiking trails with a variety of length and check out the panoramic view of four states! From the top, Georgia, Tennessee, North Carolina, and South Carolina can be seen, and on a clear day it's possible to see as far south as Atlanta. The visitor's center at the top of the mountain and the gift shop/bookstore at the base are open daily from May to October and on weekends through November.

Located in the beautiful mountains of Hiawasse, Ga, Hightower Creek Vineyards crafts small batches of premium wine from quality Georgia fruit. Enjoy a glass of wine while taking in the beautiful mountain and vineyard scenery. Tasting arrangements include a wine tasting and transportation. *(Winery closed Tuesdays & Wednesdays) (4 person minimum)*

Guided Quail Hunting

Noontootla Creek Farms is a special place to go Quail or Pheasant hunting. You will feel the thrill of this Southern Appalachian Mountain gem the first time you put your eyes on the landscape. Crisp morning air and a bountiful landscape stir the soul. In autumn, the cool mornings fire the colors of the fall leaves, which means quail hunting in the North Georgia Mountains. Half day hunts include a guide, dog, 12 birds and transportation, while full day hunts include a guide, dog, 24 birds, lunch and transportation. This excursion is located 45 minutes from the resort.

Guided Bass & Trout Fishing

The clean mountain lakes and streams provide beautiful, plentiful, and enjoyable fishing that will make your memories last for a lifetime. Trophy trout streams include the Hiawassee River and the Toccoa River. Bass and Striper fishing on Lake Nottely, Lake Chatuge, and Lake Blue Ridge is also available. Spinner or fly tackle specialization is available upon request. Transportation to all sites can be arranged along with lunches, snacks and beverages. Full day trips and/or half day trips that fit your needs for any daylight hours can be arranged.

Downtown Blueridge, Ga

Fall in love with the authentic mountain towns of Blue Ridge, Georgia. Blue Ridge is different kind of mountain town, filled with art galleries, antique and specialty shops, restaurants, small town atmosphere and friendly people. Catch the train on Blueridge Scenic Railway for a beautiful tour through the Appalachian Mountains. The rail adventure is a two hour 26 mile round trip, with a two hour layover to explore. The train runs from March through December, on weekends until June 13th, then daily through July. In the peak month of October, trips are daily beginning on October 3rd. This trip includes transportation to and from the resort as well as up to 4 hours of shopping.
